Gracie Blue's Bar

Gracie Blue's Bar is the epicentre of activity in the hotel and is the only bar in Schull with sea-views. Our bar food is served daily from 12 noon until 8:45pm. Tea, coffee, scones, and cakes are available from 9am.

We are delighted to offer continental buffet breakfast along with a delicious served hot breakfast of your choice from 7:30am – 11am (8am – 11am on Sundays) served in The Bistro. Booking is essential for breakfast – please contact reception.

Guests staying in our self-catering suites are welcome to avail of breakfast and will be charged accordingly.

Check-in / Check out

Check-in for our bedrooms is from 3pm and checkout is at 12noon sharp. Any late checkouts will incur an additional charge.

Check-in for our self-catering suites is from 4pm and checkout is at 11am sharp. Any late checkouts will incur an additional charge.

Housekeeping

Our Housekeepers will call daily between 10am and 2pm to service your room. Please use the '*Please Service Room*' sign if you would like your room serviced. Use the '*Do Not Disturb*' sign if you would like a full service. Our Housekeepers will continue to use a broad-spectrum disinfectant on all surfaces to minimise the spread of bacteria and viruses, and ensure your room is thoroughly ventilated daily. If you have any queries or requests regarding your room, please contact the front desk on '150' from 7am to 10pm, or (086) 066 2564 after 10pm.

Daily Housekeeping service is not provided for our self-catering suites. Extra towels and bedding can be provided at an extra charge.

Cots / Extra beds

Our seaview rooms and family rooms can accommodate an extra bed for children up to 12 years of age. All our bedrooms can accommodate a cot for children up to 3 years of age. Please contact reception if you require a cot or extra bed for your room. Cots are provided free of charge, while there is a charge of €15 per night for an extra bed.



Deep Blue Leisure Centre

Our Leisure Centre is located on the lower ground floor. It has a 16m heated swimming pool, a sauna, a steam room, and a gym. Towels are available at the Leisure Centre Reception.

You are required to wear a swimming hat whilst swimming, these can be purchased at the Leisure Centre Reception. We also operate our pool with reduced chlorine levels, so please shower before getting into the water.

Gym users must be 16 years or older. Sauna and steam room users must be 18 years or older.

Opening hours:

Monday – Friday 7:00am – 9:00pm (Children allowed until 6pm)

Saturday 8:00am – 9:00pm (Children allowed until 6pm)

Sunday & Bank Holidays 8:00am – 9:00pm (Children allowed until 6pm)

Please note the pool is closed for classes at certain times. Opening hours can also vary from season to season. Please ask at Reception or the Leisure Centre for current timetables. Last entry for the gym is 30 minutes prior to closing. Last entry for swimming is one hour prior to closing.

ATM Service: The nearest ATM machine is located on Main Street. There is one directly outside Centra and one inside Centra.

Banks: The nearest bank is in Skibbereen and generally opens Monday to Friday 10am to 5pm. Please call the bank for exact opening times. There is a Mobile Bank Service located in the carpark behind Centra at the following times: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 10:45am to 12:30pm and 1:30pm to 3:15pm.

Coffee & Tea: Your bedroom has complimentary tea and coffee making facilities by way of our state-of-the-art Nespresso machines. Additional supplies can be requested from the Front Desk.

Credit Cards: Most major credit cards are accepted in the hotel. Unfortunately, we do not accept American Express.

Currency Exchange: We are unable to exchange currency. Local bank

branches and credit unions have currency exchange services as well as the Post Office.

Iron & Ironing Board: There is an iron and ironing board available in all guestrooms.

Keycard: Your keycards are used for opening your bedroom door and the hotel front as well as enabling the electricity in your room. Should you mislay your key card please notify the Front Desk so that your lock can be recoded. Please return your key cards to the Front Desk on check-out. There will be a €5 charge for any keys not returned on checkout.

Maintenance: If something is not in working order, please notify the Front Desk team.

Non-Smoking: Schull Harbour Hotel is a 100% Non-Smoking hotel. All guest rooms are fitted with smoke alarms. Should anyone smoke in a room during a stay, an additional €100 charge will be applied to your account for the cost of purification. There is an outdoor smoking area to the rear of the hotel.

Parking: There is a complimentary car park across the road from the hotel entrance. During peak season this car park can get busy. The next closest car park is located on Pier Rd. Please note these are Cork Council carparks and are not managed by the hotel.

Post Office: The post office is in the centre of the village and is open Monday – Friday from 9:00am to 5:30pm and on Saturday from 9:00am to 1:00pm.

Fire Emergency

On entering your guestroom please:

- Take a few moments to familiarise yourself with the Evacuation Instructions on the back of your guestroom door.
- Locate your nearest escape route and fire alarm.
- If you have a physical condition that impairs your ability to evacuate via the staircase, please notify the Front Desk.
- Read the Security & Safety Section in this folder.

If a fire begins in your room: Leave your room, closing the door behind you to keep smoke and flames out of the corridor. Sound the alarm and leave the building via the nearest exit. DO NOT use the elevators.

In the unlikely case of a fire or upon hearing alarms:

Test the door for heat. If the door is cool, carefully check the hall for smoke. If you are in bed and there is evidence of smoke in the room, roll out of bed and crawl to the door. DO NOT STAND! Smoke and deadly gasses may rise.

If smoke or fire is present:

- 1. Close the door and call for help.
- 2. Place wet sheets and towels in cracks and vents around the doors and remove curtains.
- 3. Fill the bathtub with water to keep all fabric moistened.
- 4. Proceed to the window and try to attract attention.

If you can leave safely via the Hall:

- 1. Take your room key card with you and close the door behind you.
- 2. Exit the building via the nearest exit. Hold onto the handrail for stability.
- 3. Always remain calm.



Traveller Safety Tips

- Do not invite strangers to your room or open your guestroom door without verifying who it is first.
- Close your door securely when you leave your room and keep the door securely shut when you are in the room.
- Do not needlessly display keys, large amounts of cash or other expensive items in public or carelessly leave them anywhere where they could easily be stolen.
- Securely store your valuables in your bedroom safe.
- Do not leave valuables in your vehicle.
- Check to see that any interconnecting room doors are locked.
- If you are travelling with children, always provide adult supervision.
- If you see any suspicious activity, please report your observations to the management on duty.
